Decision

The Environmental Unit of the Municipal Authority of the Capital City of Prague (hereinafter the "EU MACCP") as the public administration body with the factual and local competence in the area of waste management pursuant to Section 26 (1) of Act No. 541/2020 Coll., on Waste, as subsequently amended (hereinafter the "Act on Waste"), and Section 31 (1) of Act No. 131/2000 Coll., on the Capital City of Prague, as subsequently amended, decided today on the basis of an application for the permission to trade in waste dated 3 February 2021 filed by a participant in the procedure: WTS-J a.s., company ID: 28102916, registered at Bezová 1658/1, 147 00 Prague 4 (hereinafter the "Applicant"),

as follows:

- The EU MACCP issues a permission to trade in waste pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Act on Waste.
- II The permission shall be granted under the following terms and conditions:

(2) This permission shall be valid until **9 March 2027**.

Rationale

The EU MACCP received the Applicant's application for the issuance of a permission to trade in waste on 3 February 2021. An administrative procedure was initiated on the date of the application's filing.

Waste can only be traded on the basis of a permission to trade in waste issued by a regional authority with the local competence pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Act on Waste.

The Applicant filed its application in compliance with the Act on Waste and supported it with all needed documents specified in Annex 3 of the Act on Waste.

The EU MACCP considered the concerned application pursuant to Section 26 (1) and Annex 3 of the Act on Waste and deems it compliant with the duties under such law.

Due to all facts provided above, the decision specified in the statement of this Decision was adopted.

This Decision is a decision of the EU MACCP as a public administration body in the area of waste management and shall not supersede any other decisions, opinions or statements under special laws.

In addition, we inform you that the concerned trader was allocated the following company ID in compliance with Section 96 (4) of the Act on Waste: COA00007. Pursuant to Section 95 of the Act on Waste, please refer to this ID in performing registration duties and duties to report, i.e. in filing reports of summarised data from preliminary registers under Section 95 (4) and in filling in and reporting data about the trader pursuant to Section 95 (1), to the administrative authority with the local and factual competence and in other communications with administrative authorities.

On 22 February 2021 an administrative charge in the amount of CZK 500 (in words: five hundred Czech crowns) was paid pursuant to Section 5 (2) of Act No. 634/2004 Coll., on Administrative Charges, as subsequently amended (hereinafter the "Act on Administrative Charges") and pursuant to item 122 of the administrative charge rate schedule, an annex of the Act on Administrative Charges, within the above-specified administrative procedure on the issuance of a permission to trade in waste.

The EU MACCP wishes to advise the Applicant that:

This permission shall be valid for six years from the moment when this Decision comes into force. In compliance with Section 26 (2) of the Act on Waste, the regional authority will always extend such validity by a maximum of another six years, if the terms and conditions for the permission's issuance are met, on the basis of an application. If the trader files an application for an extension less than six months prior to the expiry of the period of time, for which the permission had been issued, the permission shall not cease to exist before a final decision on the application is adopted.

Notice on Appeal

The participant in the procedure can file an appeal against this Decision pursuant to Section 81 et seq. of the Rules of Administrative Procedure. Such appeal should specify the extent, in which the Decision is being challenged, and the alleged contradiction with laws or incorrectness of the Decision or the procedure that preceded, with the Ministry of Environment within the deadline of 15 days from the date of the Decision's award by a submission made with the EU MACCP. It shall be inadmissible to file an appeal only against the Decision's rationale.
